Eligibility is determined by the address of the project.

Is it ok to include a quote for the proposed facilities improvements with our proposal?

Yes, it is encouraged

Is there a page limit for the NOFA response (narrative proposal)?

No

How should we indicate that our project falls within a designated URA; is it sufficient to note the physical address and the name of the URA?

It is sufficient to note the physical address of the project.

For the requested Certificate of Liability insurance, can we provide a blank COI?

DURA does not require to be a named party of the insurance during the application process. Certificates should display current status.

If you have been awarded the C-STAND grant in previous rounds, are you eligible to apply again in upcoming rounds?

Yes

Are special districts eligible to apply for DURA Community STAND Grant Funds?

Eligible organizations include small businesses, non-profits, and business improvement districts. Additional details can be found on the DURA website.

Can an RNO (Registered Neighborhood Organization) apply?

Yes.

Can funds be used for equipment, such as a screen for meetings?

Yes



Will you clarify the certificate of insurance requirements?

Organizations are required to submit proof of insurance for their organization. DURA does not require to be named at the time of application.

Can a BID apply for funding for an organization within the BID boundaries but outside of the boundaries of DURA's URAs?

No. Eligible projects must be located by address in the URAs. BIDs that include properties inside and out of the URAs should only include projects located in DURA's URAs.
