 - a. Yes

 - a. Qualification is based on the address of the project or property.
7. Can BIDS apply on behalf of the entire corridor even if ½ of corridor is in the URA?
 - a. Eligible projects reside in the URAs. No projects outside of the URAs will be awarded.
8. Can a business owner apply for 2 businesses. Same owner but different businesses?
 - a. Yes.
9. What is the required doc “Community Support Letter?”
 - a. Applicants will demonstrate positive community impact with letter(s) of support from the community. Letters can be from a neighborhood organization, community leaders, Council People, Business Improvement Districts, etc. **At least one letter of support from your community is required.**
10. Can you apply for multiple projects from the same business: marketing, improvements, murals?
 - a. Yes.
11. Our property sits mostly (80%) in the west Denver URA buffer zone. Are we eligible or disqualified based on the criteria for given for grant eligibility?
 - a. Grant eligibility is determined by the address of the project site.
12. Could you please provide more information regarding the eligibility criteria for costs associated with purchasing a permanent space?
 - a. Eligibility is determined by the address of the property.
